Constitution

1. The name of the Society is Kaslo Community Services Society.
2. The purpose of the Society is:

Kaslo Community Services Society is a non-profit, multi-service organization. The Society's mission is to develop and provide services and programs which contribute to a thriving community and enhance the quality of life for North Kootenay Lake residents.

The population served will include seniors, adults, families, adolescents and children living in the communities of Ainsworth, Mirror Lake, Kaslo, Lardeau, Cooper Creek, Meadow Creek, Howser, Argenta, Johnson's Landing and their surrounding rural areas and the Crawford Bay, Riondel and Gray Creek areas. Unique programs may be offered to residents of a wider geographic base encompassing areas where similar services are not available.

Services may include but are not limited to:

- *Counselling services - for adults, families and children*
- *Victim Services – provides support for all people who have experienced a crime, tragedy or childhood abuse.*
- *Safe Homes Program – provides safe shelter and services for women and their children experiencing violence*
- *Food Security Program – including low barrier Food Cupboard*
- *Youth Program – offering activities for youth*
- *Seniors Services*
- *Family Resource Centre*

The operations of the Society are to be chiefly carried on in the area known as Kaslo and District in the Province of British Columbia.
