Market Application

June 13th – Oct 10, 2026, Front Street Park

- The Kaslo Saturday Market runs from 9am-1pm on Saturdays, June 13th through to October 10th.
- Market Location: Front Street Park, Front Street - next to the Kaslo Hotel, downtown Kaslo.
- Stall rentals are **\$25** per day. Non-Profits **\$20** per day
 - **Discounts (when paying in advance):**
 - 10% off stall rentals if booking 10 or more days.
 - Discount only available when you pay in full by May 15th.
 - TENTS and TABLES: 10x10 tents are available to rent for \$10/day. 6ft tables are available for rent for \$5/day. There are limited numbers, so please reserve.

- Payments can be made by cheque, cash, or e-transfer. Please do not mail cash. **E-transfers** should be sent to accounts@kaslo.services Please make **cheques payable** to Kaslo Community Services Society (KCSS).
- **The Kaslo Saturday Market gives preference to returning vendors. All vendors must adhere to the BC Association of Farmer's Markets make/bake/grow guidelines.** <https://bcfarmersmarket.org/about-us/bcaf-m-by-laws-policy/>
- **Reservations** for a specific stall are available for those pre-paying for **10 or more dates**. Despite a reservation, the market manager may reassign a reserved vendor to a different stall when they feel it is necessary including when there is low vendor attendance.
- Applications to rent a stall must include a fully completed application form including initialing each clause of the **vendor obligations and responsibilities**. Incomplete applications may mean a space is not available when the complete application is received. Upon receiving the application, the Kaslo Saturday Market will review your information and connect with you.

2026 VENDOR OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

Initial each	<u>By initialing each obligation or responsibility, you indicate that you have read, understood, and agree to each.</u>
	Stall Assignment: The Market Manager makes stall assignments based on overall product balance, seasonal availability, and customer needs and demands. Vendors can reserve specific space if purchasing a minimum of 10 days . Despite reservations of specific stalls, when necessary, such as in the case of low vendor attendance, the Market Manager reserves the right to adjust the vendor layout. Vendors who have been present at previous years' markets will be given priority in assignments based on seniority. New assignments will be made in the order requests are received. Date of receipt of the request will be based on the date payment is received. All vendors must check in with the manager before setting up their booth.
	Fees: Fees are transferable to other dates with the Manager's approval. Vendors must pay for their stall space before setting up.
	Prepared Food: All vendors selling prepared foods must abide by the Food Safety guidelines of the Interior Health Authority.
	Safety and Security: Vendors are responsible for the security and safety of their products while at the Market. The Kaslo Saturday Market is not responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to vendor merchandise, displays or products at any time while at the Market.
	Tents & Tables: A limited number of tents & tables are available for rent. They must be reserved.
	Late Arrival: Stalls must be set up by 8:45am. Any vendors who are not set up and ready to open at 8:45am will be subject to a warning for the first time and then a fine for any subsequent late arrivals. The fine starts at \$10 and increases by \$5 per time.
	Cancellations: Please call or text the Market Manager at 250-353-3491 or email kaslosaturdaymarket@kaslo.services Friday evening by 8pm, at the latest, if you are not able to attend the next day market. After that it is not guaranteed your cancellation will be received in time. Late cancellations will be fined the same as the late arrival fee (one warning then a \$10 fee increasing \$5 each subsequent time).
	Parking: The Village of Kaslo has designated the area along Water Street, adjacent to Front St. Park, a loading zone. There is NO all-day parking along that stretch of the street. Vendors are asked to park their vehicles in the municipal parking lot adjacent to the Catholic Church, to allow more parking space for potential market customers.
	Vendor Stalls: Vending space is 10X10 maximum. All vendors are responsible for providing their own tables, tents, etc. or arranging to rent from the Market Manager. <u>No vendor will transfer or sublet their stall to any other person.</u> All vendors agree to confine their presentation to within the contracted space. All vendors must remove their own garbage from the Market premises at the end of the day. Each vendor is responsible for the safety and appearance of their space throughout the day. This includes keeping the area behind and around their space clean and free of clutter before, during, and after the Market. Vendors are asked not to smoke within their stalls or the marketplace.

	Liability Insurance: Please note that vendors are responsible for their own liability insurance. Vendors are <u>not</u> covered under the Kaslo Saturday Market’s insurance policy. Vendors who want insurance can access it through www.bcfarmersmarket.org/vendor.insurance.wf/
	Products Sold: All products being sold must be listed on your vendor application. If the manager sees you selling a product you haven’t listed, you may be asked to remove it from your display. The Kaslo Saturday Market adheres to the farmer’s market guidelines, as set out by the BC Association of Farmer’s Markets and has a make, bake, or grow policy. Products must be homemade, not re-sold.
	Conduct: Vendors will conduct themselves with kindness and respect towards customers, the Market Manager and other vendors. Please direct any concerns about other vendors and customers to the Market Manager. Vendors are asked not to smoke within their stalls or the marketplace. Vendors shall not accost or badger shoppers or members of the public, nor offer samples outside of their vendor stall.
	No Dogs or other pets: Vendors are prohibited from bringing dogs or other pets to the market with them. Service animals will be permitted.
	Product and pricing: Vendors must clearly and visibly display signage showing the price of each product for sale. Products must be priced at the “fair market price”.
	Right of refusal: The Kaslo Saturday Market reserves the right to refuse any applicant.
	Health & Safety: The Kaslo Saturday Market and all vendors must follow all health and safety orders of Provincial Health Officer, BC Centre for Disease Control, Work Safe BC, and BC Association of Farmers Markets. KCS may choose to require additional health and safety measures at our discretion. Safety requirements may change throughout the season. Vendors must follow the direction of the Market Manager for all health and safety issues. Refusing to follow the direction of the Market Manager may result in the vendor being removed from the site and having future reservations cancelled.

I certify that I make, bake, grow, or raise all products offered for sale at my stall at the Kaslo Saturday Market. I have read and understand each of Vendor Obligations and Responsibilities above and agree to comply with them by signing this form. I certify that information I have provided on this application is accurate, and if found to be otherwise, I agree to accept disciplinary measures as decided by the Kaslo Saturday Market, including expulsion from the market without recourse or any refund of moneys paid.
